



Green mobility

The fight against climate change and supporting the ecological transition constitute one of the main priorities of the Erasmus+ 2021-2027 program.

This priority reflects the European Green Deal, a European strategy led by the President of the Commission, which aims to achieve carbon neutrality by 2050 to combat climate change.

The Erasmus+ 2021-2027 program will strive to minimize its own environmental impact by promoting sustainable modes of transport and more responsible behaviors, as well as equipping citizens with the skills and competencies needed to contribute to environmental sustainability.

To reward individual efforts in this approach, the European Commission has implemented financial **travel support**, divided into a “standard transport” rate and an **“eco-friendly transport” rate (bus, train, carpooling, bicycle, etc.)**.

This amount is calculated based on a distance scale and is added to the support for living expenses, which is calculated according to the destination and the duration of the stay.
