## Anja DIESEL Appointed Chief Operating Officer of ICN Business School's Berlin Campus

Anja DIESEL joined ICN Business School in July 2024 as the Chief Operating Officer of the Berlin campus. Her extensive managerial experience in higher education and deep understanding of the German academic ecosystem will contribute to the development of this campus, which ICN opened in 2019 in the heart of the German capital.

With a Bachelor of Arts in Political Science from Freie Universität Berlin and a Master of Arts in European Studies from Europa-Universität Viadrina in Frankfurt, Anja DIESEL has built her professional career in Berlin. After completing her studies, she worked from 2013 to 2019 at the Center for Global Politics at Freie Universität Berlin, where she held the position of Senior Manager. In 2020, she became Campus Manager at Deutsche Pop, an academy offering training in music and media in Berlin, a role she held until December 2023.

Leveraging her extensive experience in higher education, which has made her a seasoned manager, Anja DIESEL assumed the role of Chief Operating Officer of ICN Business School's Berlin campus in July 2024. Opened in 2019, the campus offers ICN's Grande École program as well as four MSc programs: Brand and Marketing Management, International Management, Finance and Risk Management, and Management by Innovation. A new MSc program, Innovative Business Models and Greentech Startups, will be launched in the fall of 2025.
