





# MSc-MASTER OF SCIENCE IN INTERNATIONAL MANAGEMENT - MIEX

#### MISSION

Educate students to work in companies which operate internationally or intend internationalisation process. The programme journey is an international and multicultural learning experience designed to help students to acquire a global vision of doing business and familiarise themselves with methods and tools in the field of international management.

## PUBLIC

Bachelor's degree or an equivalent higher education qualification (180 ECTS minimum) or 4-year Bachelor's degree or an equivalent higher education qualification and experience (240 ECTS minimum) or Master's degree.

## PROGRAMME

Teaching language: English

Duration: 2 Years

#### Rhythm: Full Time

**Pedagogy**: the philosophy of the programme derives from the principles of reflective practice and experiential learning. Students will engage with principles and theories of business, management and organisation which will provide them with frameworks for reviewing, reflecting, analysing and critiquing existing individual and organisational practices as well as providing new knowledge and skills which will enable enhanced and more appropriate practices to be developed. The outcome of this process will be a critical appreciation, in order to build strategic and creative capabilities and to understand contemporary management and organisational issues in a context of change. The development of students as managers and leaders to maximise the performance of the organisation underpins the philosophy.

Middle and upper management positions in international companies in a variety of sectors such as Marketing, Finance and Banking, Supply Chain, Business Development and Management consultancy.

#### **ENTRY PROCESS**

The first stage of the admissions process consists of an analysis of the application documents (completed on-line application form, scanned copies of academic transcripts, two references, a letter of motivation and CV) and the second phase is a personal interview on demand by the programme director. Applicants must evidence of an appropriate level of English (TOEFL 80 or equivalent) for programmes taught in English.

## ASSESSMENT POLICY

Assessment of courses may require group and/or individual continuous assessment in addition to final written examination. The organisation of examinations is the responsibility of each MIEX partner and is carried out by the local professors under the direction and control of the Local Director of Studies and in line with local practices and regulations.
